#### **Updates**

- Farmer's market table: Bob G. Jeanette, Sam: went extremely well, lots of interest in amphibians, importance of hands-on opportunities; education components.
- ACFC Update Sam: There is to be a rotating chair, 3-month rotations; role of RCC in Management Plan (MP) discussed ACFC wants RCC involvement RCC would welcome ACFC request to do so; Jimmy Cochran and Sam Pratt unanimously approved for recommendation to Selectboard; Ian Stokes to take stab at MP revisions before going to RFP 45-day timeline
- Trails update: Lou Borie summarized situation; see October RCC Minutes; situation in limbo; water redirected again; will need to keep tabs, including on State
- BioFinder: Renewed publicity; importance of prework tutorial, story map; need to clarify if workshop needs to be warned; Bob L. cited land use layers available
- Old Jerico Road situation: report on meeting Josh Arnason, Bob Low, Judy –
  encouraging discussion ongoing with FEMA contact (Tim); may be able to go beyond
  simple restoration based on pre-existing recreational trail; cost to Town with FEMA
  and State awards will be minimal; Additional \$\$\$ may be available; second meeting

with Josh scheduled; FEMA award covers both trail and bridge; issue – which comes first - general consensus that trail should be first if need to divide (what use is bridge without a trail); issue of likely repeat if washout / damage in future flood events, should anything be done.

 Sam discussed pre-distributed CCRPC Best Practices policy (posted); need to understand where Richmond is at re Zoning in terms of building locations / envelopes and related - discuss with Planning Commission

- UVM student Climate study for Richmond: Bob L. described Underhill study under Lesley-Ann Dupigny-Giroux, will follow up at next RCC meeting
