Including a Geomorphic study and the health of the whole system. They encouraged us to go for an RFP. Callie and Tyler then met with Josh Arneson this week and we will be receiving from FEMA \$130,000. We could pursue a design build RFP. Plan to connect with Chris Burnell first, then

Duncan Wardwell would write the RFP. Callie will follow up with Josh to keep this moving along.

- -Replacing bridge near the canoe access. Jean will check with Richmond Land Trust to have Rod West drive on the RLT property to put in a tree bridge.
- -Johnny Brook Trail Nov 2nd work day to add a deck to the boardwalk on the trail.
- -Flip the bridge on the Rivershore Trail Monday Oct 21st at 5:30pm park at Cochran's bring shovels, rockbars.
- -Switching the trail status from spreadsheet to Trail Forks. Discussed doing it by encoding the Trailforks status on the site's website. Hannah will share the switch with interested parties.
- -Chris Webster asked about Huckleberry Hill determined that the property he was interested in is in Jericho.
