RE: Application for Final Water & Sewer Allocation for EM0112

Dear Ms. Knowles and Mr. Parisi,

This letter is a notification that the Water and Sewer Commission will consider approving final allocation of the following preliminary allocation at 112 East Main St. at their meeting on Monday, May 6, 2024:

- Existing Water Demand = 2 units @ 280 gpd/unit (140 gpd/bedroom @ 2 bedrooms each) = 560 gpd
- Additional Water Demand = 1 unit @ 360 gpd/unit (municipal connection) = 360 gpd
- Total Proposed Water Demand = 560 + 360 = 920 gpd
- Existing Sewer Flow = 2 units @ 210 gpd/unit (municipal connection >50,000 gpd) = 420 gpd
- Additional Sewer Flow = 1 unit @ 210 gpd/unit (municipal connection >50,000 gpd) = 210 gpd
- Total Proposed Sewer Flow = 420 + 210 = 630 gpd

The Town is in receipt of a check to pay for the final allocation charges as follows:

- Additional Water Allocation of 360 gpd @ \$1.89 per gallon: \$680.40
- Additional Sewer Allocation of 210 gpd @ \$4.41 per gallon: \$926.10
- Total combined due for Water and Sewer Allocations: \$1,606.50

The allocation being considered for finalization is for the building with Water and Wastewater account number 1385. The duplex with Water and Wastewater account number 1390 has a water allocation of 560 GPD and a wastewater allocation of 420 GPD. These figures are provided to clarify the allocation per building as it is my understanding you intend to proceed with a subdivision at some point in the future. When you do so, you will need to come back to the Commission with a request to split the allocation between the two lots and these figures should make it clear how much allocation goes with each lot.
